
COVENANT

Four times (verses 1, 2, 6, and 8) God called the Lord, the God who enters into covenant with us by grace. This unfamiliar word means his love is "locked on to us" in unending commitment. Thus it says *for* us (verses 1-2). But the psalmist could not see what we can see. God is ever on our side, because in Christ our sins can't bring us into condemnation (Romans 8:1, 34-35). So not "trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword... will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 8:35, 39). Since the maker of heaven and earth is (through Christ) our help, we will not fear (verse 8). What could be against us (Romans 8:31)?
