## **God, I'm Listening**

Has God spoken to you recently?

During World War II, a young woman had studied Morse code and applied for a job as a telegraph operator. She was invited to an interview. When she arrived she found the waiting area filled with other applicants who were chatting nervously in anticipation of getting the vacant position. The young woman took a seat and waited. Then, all of a sudden, she jumped up and walked briskly into the adjoining room. The others looked up but went on chatting. Shortly afterwards, the manager appeared to tell the group that the job had been filled. He explained that he had been tapping on his window in Morse code: 'If you can understand this, come inside. You're hired!'

We need to be attentive to hear God speaking to us. The prophet Elijah learned that God doesn't shout his instructions. He doesn't normally pass on guidance in any dramatic way, such as through the howling wind, earthquake or fire. Rather, it is through the quiet reflective reading of his word; it is while we are engaging in prayer or being attentive to God through the day that he whispers into our hearts. Have you been listening lately? If so, has God been calling you to some action?

### From Pastor Luciano

Dear Gordon and Sarah,

Thank you for your kind request. It's an honour to give details regarding our children's ministry here in the Philippines.

Our Hope Philippines Ministries of Davao City Inc ministry is mainly serving less fortunate children in our area here.

Sponsorship Ministry, for which you have sponsored several children, has the primary purpose of helping to cover the extra cost of school needs for these poor children.

Though education is free and state-funded, there are other costs that need to be covered: education supplies and uniforms, for example. The cost of travel is a huge burden to be shouldered by the families of less fortunate children.

Your sponsored children receive cash assistance from you, which is given after our Sunday church services. Your support of \$30 a month is divided by 4 weeks to ensure that the children will be present at church each Sunday.

All those children you have already sponsored have been taught how to have a relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ and have eventually become members of our fellowship.

The help we offer to the needy families outside of our fellowship takes the form of prayers and Bible study, except for those you have already sponsored and who receive your educational assistance.

The children you have seen in the photos sent regularly are not yet part of our fellowship. They are the children of our 5 outreach areas, where we are ministering every week.

Together with several sponsored children, whom we have trained to teach Bible stories and lead children's prayers and games, we have been ministering to poor children every Saturday morning and afternoon. We have also been feeding one outreach area every week after kids activities.
