Therefore

One word can make all the difference.

Every religion has a *law*, describing how we ought to live. Christianity has this in the Ten Commandments in the Old Testament, and Jesus' Sermon on the Mount in the New. But only Christianity has a "therefore" that always goes before it!

All other religions say that if we improve and discipline our lives obey the law - then God will reward and bless us. Christianity is the opposite; it says that God has blessed us first - i.e., as a gift of His merciful love in Jesus Christ, He has paid for and forgiven all our sins, accepts and counts us His true children, who will enjoy His good gifts forever. All of this is ours through faith in Jesus Christ.

Having announced this good news, the Christian Gospel then says, "Therefore be imitators of God,..." (Eph 5:1).

That is, because God has first loved us, cleansed and forgiven us, and given us an entirely new status and life as His children as a

gift of His grace, "therefore follow my law - my good will and purpose for your lives". To do so is simply an expression of our thanksgiving, love and joy for the gifts of His love that we have already received.
