News reports regularly tell us that levels of public cynicism towards politicians are at an all-time high. The perpetual criticism of the political sphere is that words of promise are not backed up with action. But come to think of it... I've been hearing those news reports for 50 odd years!

Well - if those news reports are true - God wouldn't make a good politician, because His Word never lacks action. When God speaks, stuff happens (Is 55:11)! For example, rocks get smashed to pieces (Jeremiah 23:29), the earth gets watered and seeds grow (Isaiah 55:10), thoughts and intentions of the heart are split open (Hebrews 4:12), people are set free from captivity (John 8:32), sins are forgiven (Luke 7:48), people are saved (Romans 1:16), dead people are raised to life (John 11:43).

There is nothing more active and powerful in the universe than God's Word. James says that God has given us birth through His Word, that we might be first fruits of His Word (James 1:18).
