#### **SLEEP**

Have you ever pondered the enigmatic third of your life spent in slumber? It's a captivating notion, especially when we often overlook this substantial part of our existence. Beyond the occasional vivid dream, we often can't recall what unfolds during those silent, unconscious hours. What could be the spiritual significance of this mysterious state?

Interestingly, the Bible uses the term 'sleep' in various symbolic contexts, each carrying a profound spiritual message. It's equated with laziness, spiritual apathy, being unprepared for Christ's return, and even as a precursor to the resurrection. These references invite us to ponder the deeper spiritual implications of our sleep.

On the other hand, there are passages that speak of God's unique protection over his children as they sleep. The wise man Solomon acknowledged, 'He (God) gives his beloved sleep' (Psalm 127.2). This is the sleep of contentment, knowing that our God never slumbers nor sleeps (Psalm 121.4). How does this knowledge of God's constant vigilance make you feel?
